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A. Pendahuluan

Seiring dengan perkembangan serta kemajuan teknologi dan komunikasi yang begitu pesat saat ini, kerjasama antar negara mutlak diperlukan oleh bangsa-bangsa di dunia ini, khususnya bangsa-bangsa di Asia Tenggara. Di antara negara-negara Asia Tenggara (ASEAN) sekarang ini kerjasama diberbagai bidang terus ditingkatkan baik di bidang politik, ekonomi, pertahanan, dan pendidikan. Namun, disamping kerjasama tersebut tidak dapat dipungkiri bahwa sesungguhnya juga terjadi "persaingan". Oleh karenanya, dalam perkembangan dunia yang semakin cepat menghadapi tantangan persaingan dalam era 4.0 sekarang ini, khususnya persaingan dalam *ASEAN pasar bebas dan teknologi*, Indonesia perlu segera meningkatkan kemampuan Sumber Daya Manusia (SDM) nya. Peningkatan kemampuan SDM ini perlu dilakukan untuk semua lembaga termasuk lembaga pendidikan. Pascasarjana (PPs) Universitas PGRI Palembang melalui salah satu mata kuliah prasyarat nya, yaitu "Isu-isu Pendidikan Internasional" memberikan kesempatan kepada mahasiswa untuk mengembangkan pengetahuan dan keterampilannya melalui kegiatan studi internasional.

Sebagai salah satu lembaga pendidikan terkemuka di kota Palembang, Universitas PGRI Palembang melalui PPs telah dan terus menjalin kerjasama dengan beberapa Universitas baik di dalam maupun di luar negeri. Kerjasama dengan luar negeri Malaysia, khususnya dengan *University Of Malaya* terus dijalin dan diperkuat. C. Manfaat

Adapun manfaat dari Seminar Internasional ini adalah sebagai berikut:

1. Universitas PGRI dapat menjalin kerjasama dengan Universitas yang ada di Malaysia dan mendapatkan informasi serta sistem administrasi dan akademik yang ada di *University of Malaya*.
2. Mahasiswa dapat mengenali dunia pendidikan dengan lebih luas serta dapat menambah wawasan dan pengetahuan yang berharga untuk memperoleh masukan serta umpan balik guna memperbaiki dan mengembangkan kesesuaian pendidikan yang dialaminya dengan pendidikan internasional dan kenyataan yang ada di lapangan;
3. Mahasiswa dapat meningkatkan pengetahuan dan pengalaman dengan mengikuti seminar internasional;
4. Menumbuhkan dan meningkatkan sikap profesional yang diperlukan mahasiswa untuk memasuki era revolusi 4.0 serta dapat menambah keterampilan berbahasa asing (Inggris) dan wawasan dalam dunia pendidikan yang profesional dan handal.
5. Meningkatkan pengetahuan dan wawasan mahasiswa tentang pemahaman lintas budaya, serta meningkatkan kualitas mahasiswa, yaitu mahasiswa yang memiliki tingkat pengetahuan, keterampilan, etos kerja yang sesuai dengan tuntutan lapangan pekerjaan.

E. Pelaksanaan dan Jadwal Seminar Internasional

Kegiatan konferensi ini dilaksanakan dengan mendengarkan paparan/penjelasan dari nara sumber yang berasal dari berbagai Universitas yang ada di Malaysia dan manca negara yang dilaksanakan dengan sistem paparan/tutorial dan tanya jawab, serta sistem paralel. Setelah itu dilakukan tanya jawab. Penyajian materi dilaksanakan dalam waktu kurang - lebih 45 menit dan 30 menit untuk tanya jawab dan diskusi. Seminar ini dilaksanakan bertempat di Paum Club house, 10476, Jalan Susur Damansara 59100 Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia tanggal 23 Juni 2022.

F. Peserta Seminar Internasional

Seminar internasional ini diikuti oleh mahasiswa Program Studi (PS) Bahasa dan Sastra Indonesia, mahasiswa PS Bahasa Inggris serta mahasiswa PS Manajemen Pendidikan PPs semester 2, para pimpinan, dosen dan pengelola sebanyak 391 orang serta peserta dari berbagai negara ASEAN, ASIA, dan lainnya.

G. Waktu dan Tempat

Seminar internasional ini dilaksanakan pada tanggal 23 Desember 2023 bertempat di Paum Club house, 10476, Jalan Susur Damansara 59100 Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia.

H. Pembiayaan/Sumber Dana

Pembiayaan/sumber dana untuk kegiatan seminar internasional ini dibebankan pada mahasiswa semester 2 Program Studi Magister Pendidikan Bahasa dan Sastra Indonesia, mahasiswa Program Studi Magister Pendidikan Bahasa Inggris dan mahasiswa Program Studi Magister Manajemen Pendidikan Pascasarjana Universitas PGRI Palembang yang mengikuti seminar ini.

I. Penawaran MoU /Program Kerjasama

**AGREEMENT FOR ACADEMIC COOPERATION AND EXCHANGE
BETWEEN
UNIVERSITI MALAYA
AND
UNIVERSITAS PGRI PALEMBANG**

Faculty of Languages and Linguistics, Universiti Malaya (henceforth UM) and Universitas PGRI Palembang which for the purpose of this Agreement is represented by Pascasarjana (henceforth Palembang) enter into the following terms of agreement with respect to furthering educational and academic exchange between the two institutions.

Article 1. UM and Palembang agree to cooperate in order to expand opportunities for the education of students and to facilitate academic research among faculty members and researchers.

Article 2. In order to promote the cooperation described in Article 1, both institutions **may carry out various kinds of activities as listed below, and the details of the collaboration shall be specified and agreed in writing by further consultation** between the two institutions.

- (1) Exchange of faculty members, researchers and students
- (2) Research collaboration
- (3) Joint organisation of workshop, seminar and conference
- (4) International conference participation
- (5) Other activities mutually agreed upon between the two parties

Article 3. Detailed management of intellectual property rights and publication shall be defined in a separate written agreement for each activity agreed in Article 2.

Article 3.1 Financial Agreement

The financial agreements for each activity agreed in Article 2, shall be negotiated and agreed upon by both Parties in writing.

Article 4. The differing viewpoints and interpretations of this agreement shall be settled amicably by mutual consultation or negotiation.

Article 5. Amendments to this agreement may be made upon mutual written agreement between the two institutions.

Article 6. This agreement may be terminated by either party after six (6) months written notice to the other party.

Article 7. In cases that the activities under Article 2 continue after the termination of this agreement, both institutions will cooperate with each other in good faith in accordance with such activities until those activities come to an end.

Article 8. This agreement is made in English as the mutually agreed official language. Two (2) copies of this agreement are made and signed in original by both institutions.

Article 9. This agreement shall take effect on and from the date of execution of this agreement and shall continue to be effective for a period of five (5) years and may be extended for such further period as may be agreed by the Parties in writing.

Article 10. This Academic Cooperation And Exchange is not intended to be legally binding. It merely expresses the intentions and understanding of the parties which will form the basis of any legally binding agreement to be drafted and executed in the future.

Article 11. Every notice, request or any other communication required or permitted to be given pursuant to this agreement shall be in writing, in English and delivered personally or sent by registered or certified post via air mail or by courier or facsimile (which shall be acknowledged by the other Party) to the Parties at the address and facsimile number as stated below:

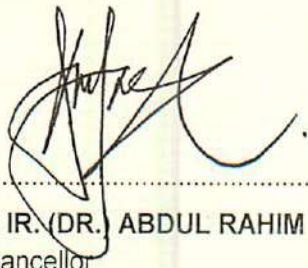

**MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT
EDUCATION, RESEARCH AND PUBLICATION OF SCIENTIFIC WORKS**

**BETWEEN

FACULTY OF EDUCATION UNIVERSITY MALAYA

It has been agreed by and between:

Faculty Of Teacher Training And Education PGRI Palembang University (hereinafter called the first party), represented by **Assoc.Prof. Dr. Dessy Wardiah, M.Pd., CIQaR** in her capacity as Dean Faculty Of Teacher Training And Education PGRI Palembang University hereinafter referred to as **FIRST PARTY**.

and

Faculty of Education, Universiti Malaya (hereinafter called the second party) represented by **Dr. Nor Eeza Binti Zainal Abidin** in his capacity as as Lecturer at the Faculty of Sports and Exercise Science, Universiti Malaya hereinafter referred to as **SECOND PARTY**.

**ARTICLE 1
SCOPE OF WORK**

The purpose of this Memorandum of Agreement (MoA) is to set forth the terms and conditions, scope of work and responsibilities of the parties associated with the collaboration on **Education, Research And Publication Of Scientific Works** on the basis of equality.

ARTICLE 2

RESPONSIBILITIES

This type of activity includes the following provisions – shall cover the following provisions:

1. Providing Resources: The first party must be willing to provide necessary resources, such as funds, facilities, or personnel, in accordance with established agreements.
2. Developing a Program or Initiative: The first party may have responsibility for developing the program or initiative that is the focus of the collaboration, including planning, implementation, and evaluation.
3. Facilitating Collaboration: The first party must play an active role in facilitating collaboration between the two parties, including facilitating meetings, communication and coordination between the teams or individuals involved.
4. Develop a Joint Work Plan: The first party must work together with the other party to develop a clear and structured joint work plan, which includes objectives, time and tasks to be completed.
5. Maintaining Openness and Transparency: The first party must maintain openness and transparency in carrying out cooperation, including providing required information and communicating important changes or developments to other parties.
6. Responding to Needs and Changes: The first party must be responsive to needs and changes that may occur during the course of the collaboration, and be willing to adjust strategies or work approaches if necessary.
7. Maintaining Quality and Standards: The first party must ensure that the collaboration is carried out in accordance with the established quality standards and that the results of the collaboration meet the expectations and objectives that have been set.

Obligations include the following provisions – shall cover the following provisions:

1. Active Participation: The second party must participate actively in the implementation of the collaboration, including in meetings, discussions and other activities related to the goals of the collaboration.
2. Fulfilling Commitments: The second party must fulfill all commitments agreed within the cooperation framework, including in terms of time, resources and expected results.
3. Providing Contributions: The second party may be asked to provide contributions in the form of resources, knowledge, or expertise necessary to achieve the goals of the collaboration.
4. Respect Rules and Standards: Both parties must respect the rules, regulations and standards that apply in cooperation, and maintain integrity and ethics in implementing cooperation.
5. Participate in Evaluation: The second party must be willing to participate in the evaluation process carried out to evaluate the progress and results of the collaboration, as well as provide constructive feedback.
6. Facilitate Communication: The second party must facilitate effective communication between parties involved in the collaboration, as well as maintain open and transparent communication channels.

7. **Maintaining Confidentiality:** Both parties must maintain the confidentiality of sensitive or confidential information obtained during the collaboration, as well as respecting intellectual property rights that may be involved.
8. **Overcoming Obstacles:** The second party must be willing to overcome obstacles or challenges that may arise during the implementation of the collaboration, as well as finding appropriate solutions to overcome these problems.

ARTICLE 3

FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENTS

1. **Initial Financing:** Which party will be responsible for the initial costs required to start the collaboration, such as program development costs, infrastructure, or other resources
2. **Operational Costs:** How operational costs will be shared between the two parties during the implementation of the collaboration, including management and administration costs, staff salaries, and other related costs.
3. **Source of Financing:** Source of financing that will be used to support collaboration, whether it comes from internal funds of each party, grants, sponsors, or other sources of financing.
4. **Financial Obligations:** Are there any financial obligations that must be fulfilled by each party during the collaboration, such as payment of monthly or annual contributions, or sharing of income generated from the collaboration.
5. **Fund Management:** How cooperation funds will be managed and accounted for, including expenditure procedures, financial reporting and audits that will be carried out periodically.
6. **Financial Arrangements:** Establishment of an agreement or contract that regulates the financial aspects of the collaboration, including the sharing of financial risks and responsibilities between the two parties.
7. **Cost Changes:** Procedures for handling cost changes that may occur during the implementation of the collaboration, including changes in budget, resources, or project scope.
8. **Financial Guarantees:** Are there any financial guarantees that will be provided by each party to ensure the continuity and success of the collaboration, such as guarantees or insurance.
9. **Dispute Resolution:** Dispute resolution procedures that will be applied if a dispute arises related to the financing or financial aspects of the collaboration.

ARTICLE 4

DURATION OF AGREEMENT

This Agreement remain into force for a period of 5 (five) Year being in effect from the date of signing of this MoA. It may be extended for any further period/s upon mutual consent in writing by both Parties.

ARTICLE 5

AGREEMENT OF PAYMENT

It is agreed to by both parties that the cost of this contract will be shared between Faculty Of Teacher Training And Education Pgri Palembang University and Faculty of Education Universiti Malaya as outlined in Article 2. Responsibilities.

ARTICLE 6

DISPUTE RESOLUTION

The First Party and The Second Party shall base their contractual relationship on the fundamental principles of goodwill and good faith. Any differing viewpoints and interpretations of this Agreement shall be settled by mutual consultation or negotiation.

ARTICLE 7

MISCELLANEOUS

1. The agreement shall bind and inure to the benefit of the parties, their respective successors and permitted assigns.
2. In the event of any conflict between this Agreement and any Exhibits hereto, the terms of this Agreement shall govern. This Agreement may only be ended in writing signed by both parties that explicitly states that it is intended to amend this Agreement.
3. The Contract shall be effective and come into force when it is signed by both Parties. In witness where of authorized representative of the Parties here to have set their hands this day and year first above written.

ARTICLE 8

ARTICLE 1

**SCOPE OF
WORK**

The purpose of this Implementation of Agreement (IA) is to set forth the terms and conditions, scope of work and responsibilities of the parties associated with the collaboration on **Education, Research And Publication Of Scientific Works** on the basis of equality.

ARTICLE 2

RESPONSIBILITIES

This type of activity includes the following provisions – shall cover the following provisions:

1. Providing Resources: The first party must be willing to provide necessary resources, such as funds, facilities, or personnel, in accordance with established agreements.
2. Developing a Program or Initiative: The first party may have responsibility for developing the program or initiative that is the focus of the collaboration, including planning, implementation, and evaluation.
3. Facilitating Collaboration: The first party must play an active role in facilitating collaboration between the two parties, including facilitating meetings, communication and coordination between the teams or individuals involved.
4. Develop a Joint Work Plan: The first party must work together with the other party to develop a clear and structured joint work plan, which includes objectives, time and tasks to be completed.
5. Maintaining Openness and Transparency: The first party must maintain openness and transparency in carrying out cooperation, including providing required information and communicating important changes or developments to other parties.
6. Responding to Needs and Changes: The first party must be responsive to needs and changes that may occur during the course of the collaboration, and be willing to adjust strategies or work approaches if necessary.
7. Maintaining Quality and Standards: The first party must ensure that the collaboration is carried out in accordance with the established quality standards and that the results of the collaboration meet the expectations and objectives that have been set.

Obligations include the following provisions – shall cover the following provisions:

1. Active Participation: The second party must participate actively in the implementation of the collaboration, including in meetings, discussions and other activities related to the goals of the collaboration.
2. Fulfilling Commitments: The second party must fulfill all commitments agreed within the cooperation framework, including in terms of time, resources and expected results.
3. Providing Contributions: The second party may be asked to provide contributions in the form of resources, knowledge, or expertise necessary to achieve the goals of the collaboration.
4. Respect Rules and Standards: Both parties must respect the rules, regulations and standards that apply in cooperation, and maintain integrity and ethics in implementing cooperation.
5. Participate in Evaluation: The second party must be willing to participate in the evaluation process carried out to evaluate the progress and results of the collaboration, as well as provide constructive feedback.
6. Facilitate Communication: The second party must facilitate effective communication between parties involved in the collaboration, as well as maintain open and transparent communication channels.

7. **Maintaining Confidentiality:** Both parties must maintain the confidentiality of sensitive or confidential information obtained during the collaboration, as well as respecting intellectual property rights that may be involved.
8. **Overcoming Obstacles:** The second party must be willing to overcome obstacles or challenges that may arise during the implementation of the collaboration, as well as finding appropriate solutions to overcome these problems.

ARTICLE 3

FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENTS

1. **Initial Financing:** Which party will be responsible for the initial costs required to start the collaboration, such as program development costs, infrastructure, or other resources
2. **Operational Costs:** How operational costs will be shared between the two parties during the implementation of the collaboration, including management and administration costs, staff salaries, and other related costs.
3. **Source of Financing:** Source of financing that will be used to support collaboration, whether it comes from internal funds of each party, grants, sponsors, or other sources of financing.
4. **Financial Obligations:** Are there any financial obligations that must be fulfilled by each party during the collaboration, such as payment of monthly or annual contributions, or sharing of income generated from the collaboration.
5. **Fund Management:** How cooperation funds will be managed and accounted for, including expenditure procedures, financial reporting and audits that will be carried out periodically.
6. **Financial Arrangements:** Establishment of an agreement or contract that regulates the financial aspects of the collaboration, including the sharing of financial risks and responsibilities between the two parties.
7. **Cost Changes:** Procedures for handling cost changes that may occur during the implementation of the collaboration, including changes in budget, resources, or project scope.
8. **Financial Guarantees:** Are there any financial guarantees that will be provided by each party to ensure the continuity and success of the collaboration, such as guarantees or insurance.
9. **Dispute Resolution:** Dispute resolution procedures that will be applied if a dispute arises related to the financing or financial aspects of the collaboration.

ARTICLE 4

DURATION OF AGREEMENT

This Agreement remain into force for a period of 5 (five) Year being in effect from the date of signing of this MoA. It may be extended for any further period/s upon mutual consent in writing by both Parties.

ARTICLE 5

AGREEMENT OF PAYMENT

It is agreed to by both parties that the cost of this contract will be shared between **Graduate Program Universitas PGRI Palembang** and **Faculty of Education University of Malaya** as outlined in Article 2. Responsibilities.

ARTICLE 6

DISPUTE RESOLUTION

The First Party and The Second Party shall base their contractual relationship on the fundamental principles of goodwill and good faith. Any differing viewpoints and interpretations of this Agreement shall be settled by mutual consultation or negotiation.

ARTICLE 7

MISCELLANEOUS

1. The agreement shall bind and inure to the benefit of the parties, their respective successors and permitted assigns.
2. In the event of any conflict between this Agreement and any Exhibits hereto, the terms of this Agreement shall govern. This Agreement may only be ended in writing signed by both parties that explicitly states that it is intended to amend this Agreement.
3. The Contract shall be effective and come into force when it is signed by both Parties. In witness where of authorized representative of the Parties here to have set their hands this day and year first above written.
