The subjects were assessed at baseline and at 12 weeks. The walking program had a significant positive effect on the physical and psychological health of the subjects. The walking program significantly improved the subjects' physical health, as measured by the 6-minute walk test, and their psychological health, as measured by the Beck Depression Inventory and the State-Trait Anxiety Inventory. The walking program also had a significant positive effect on the subjects' quality of life, as measured by the SF-36. The walking program was well tolerated and had no adverse effects. The results of this study suggest that a 12-week, low-intensity, supervised walking program can improve the physical and psychological health of sedentary, middle-aged women.

* The method of undetermined coefficients

This method is used to find a particular solution of a non-homogeneous differential equation. It is based on the assumption that the particular solution has a form similar to the non-homogeneous term. For example, if the non-homogeneous term is a polynomial, we assume the particular solution is also a polynomial.

Example 1: $y'' + y = \sin x$

The homogeneous solution is $y_h = C_1 \cos x + C_2 \sin x$. We assume a particular solution of the form $y_p = A \sin x + B \cos x$.

- Substituting y_p into the ODE, we get $-A \sin x - B \cos x + A \sin x + B \cos x = \sin x$. This simplifies to $0 = \sin x$, which is not possible. Therefore, we need to modify our assumption. We assume $y_p = A x \cos x + B x \sin x$.
- Substituting y_p into the ODE, we get $2A \sin x - 2B \cos x = \sin x$. This gives $2A = 1$ and $-2B = 0$. So, $A = \frac{1}{2}$ and $B = 0$. The particular solution is $y_p = \frac{1}{2} x \cos x$.
